

# Sporting success for KDS, Bialik

BIALIK College and The King David School are reaping the rewards of their sports programs after a successful finals campaign last month.

Playing in different divisions, the two schools made it to a combined 10 grand finals from years 8-12.

In the senior sport finals held a fortnight ago, Bialik were victors in boys basketball, boys soccer and girls hockey. In the boys basketball, Bialik overcame the odds, defeating favourite Oxley College who had previously won every championship from 2011-2015.

The boys soccer team trounced their opposition 14-1, while the girls hockey team shared the honours with Plenty Valley after the governing body ruled the premiership to be shared in the case of a draw. The girls netball and southern boys soccer teams were both runners-up in their respective grand finals.

At King David, the girls basketball team were looking to win their third premiership in a row; however, they fell short to a strong Donvale outfit.

In the middle school category, King David added an extra two trophies to their cabinet by taking out the year 8/9 boys touch rugby and basketball competitions. After being runners-up last year, the touch

rugby team were able to go the extra step further and be crowned champions, while the basketball team defeated Donvale by 19 points.

Meanwhile at Bialik, the boys took home the year 8/9 soccer premiership defeating Knox College in a tight 3-2 victory. Unfortunately for the girls netball team, they fell at the final hurdle losing by eight points.
