

KIDS TO BENEFIT FROM COMPUTER DONATION

STUDENTS at Sunshine College will be able to enjoy more screen time next term, thanks to a charitable donation.

Fifty computers, worth over \$20,000, have been distributed to the college through the Ardoch Youth Foundation.

The computers were donated to the foundation by Bialik College in Hawthorn East.

The Ardoch Youth Foundation, a charity that provides education support for children and young people, has more than 50 partner schools in inner Melbourne, the western suburbs, Frankston and Geelong.

Ardoch aims to overcome barriers to education by providing schools in need with working technology, stationery, emergency toiletries, text books, library books and other items.

Ardoch representative Rachel Morley said the 50 computers from Bialik College would “greatly benefit” the students at Sunshine College.

The college’s student wellbeing leader, Wai-Ling Hui, also welcomed the donation.

“We have a number of broken and damaged computers and never seem to have enough computers for student use,” she said.

“This generous donation will benefit our students. We will be able to set up another computer lab in the school.”
