

# Bialik remembers

BIALIK College will be the only school representing Victoria at this year's Remembrance Day ceremony at the Australian War Memorial in Canberra on November 11.

The 12 students from year 6 will be honouring the fallen soldiers' lives along with 90 other school students from across the country.

The 102 selected students recall the 102,000 servicemen and women who have given their lives in war and other operations over more than a century, with the representatives given the opportunity to place a poppy at the Stone of Remembrance.

Bialik's principal Jeremy Stowe-Lindner said the college is honoured and "immensely proud" to represent the state at this integral event.

"We were asked to participate as a result of the enthusiasm and respect our students showed during their last visit to Canberra," Stowe-Lindner said.
