### Terrific track and field results

JEWISH athletes performed strongly at last week's division 3 Eastern Independent Schools Melbourne (EISM) athletics carnival at Lakeside Stadium.

Bialik College's Lexia Paul dominated her U13 girls age group, winning the 100m (14.72), 200m (31.39) and high jump (1.35m).
